Conditions Treated

- Achalasia
- Diffuse esophageal spasm
- Nutcracker esophagus
- Pseudoachalasia
- Esophageal diverticulum
- Recurrent dysphagia post-Heller

Diagnostic Procedures

- High-resolution manometry
- 24-hour pH Bravo probe
- Impedence testing

Therapies

- Per-oral endoscopic myotomy (POEM)
- Laparoscopic Heller myotomy
- Laparoscopic diverticulectomy
- Endoscopic Botox
