#### **Conditions Treated**

Lung cancer

Lung cancer in the elderly and in patients with end-stage emphysema

• Indeterminate lung nodule

• Airway strictures and cancer

# **Therapies**

- VATS (video-assisted thoracic surgery) lobectomy
- VATS sublobar resection for patients with severe emphysema
- Endoscopic therapies, including laser, argon beam and stenting for airway strictures
- Advanced noninvasive diagnostic modalities, including EBUS (endobronchial ultrasound) and navigation bronchoscopy

## **Distinguishing Features**

- Multidisciplinary care, including interventional pulmonologists, minimally invasive surgeons, radiation oncologists and medical oncologists
- Peri-operative lobectomy mortality rate of just 0.22 percent, one-fifth the national average for tertiary care hospitals
