

# MyChart Bedside

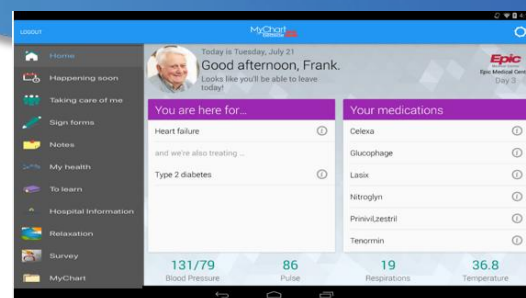


**What-** MyChart Bedside is a Tablet application for *patients* to use while hospitalized.

**Why-** Increase patient engagement and satisfaction

- Put names to faces of treatment team members
- See and learn about their medications
- See lab test results when finalized

## Key Activities Available to Patients in MyChart Bedside:



**Happening Soon:** The patient will see their scheduled medications and tests.

**Taking Care of Me:** Treatment team members will display with generic role descriptions.

**Sign Forms:** As consents become available within EPIC they can be reviewed and signed here.

**Notes to Self:** The patient can write down questions to present to their care team on rounds. Patients can also record Audio and Video notes, such as how to perform self care at home; these will be stored in MyChart for review after discharge.

**My Health:** Displays lab test results that are finalized by 9am and the most recent vital signs. Imaging results do not display. Follows the same rules as MyChart for sensitive results to be released in 3 business days.

**To Learn:** Assigned videos and handouts display in here for the patient to view at their convenience and are sent to MyChart for review after discharge.

**MyChart:** Patients have the opportunity to sign up for a MyChart account within Bedside

## How The Healthcare Team can use MyChart Bedside when interacting with the patient.

- Add yourself to the patient's Treatment Team so patients will see you listed in *Taking Care of Me*.
- If you are no longer involved in the patient's care, remove yourself from the Treatment Team.
- Review and teach the patient about their medications.
- Review test results.
- Review the patient's Notes to Self section.
- Encourage patient to sign up for MyChart within the tablet.

**Note: The Problem List is visible to patients-** active (in hospital) problems will display on the Home screen

- If you do not want a problem to display to the patient, **unselect "Share with Patient"** in the problem list
