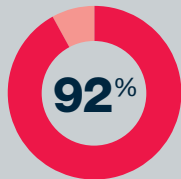

## THE FIRST AND ONLY DEDICATED AMPUTATION-PREVENTION CENTER IN THE BAY AREA

- Compassionate, patient-centered care with an emphasis on early treatment to maintain independent ambulation and limb health
- Founded in 2011 and receives referrals from California, the United States and the world
- Vascular surgeons and podiatrists who see patients at the same visit to create a unique treatment plan together
- Focus on limb-threatening conditions such as advanced vascular disease and nonhealing diabetic foot ulcers
- Prevention, treatment and avoiding recurrence of foot ulcers in diabetic patients, enabling them to return to independent walking
- State-of-the-art limb preservation techniques including minimally invasive vascular procedures, and limb-sparing surgery with advanced fixation, bone transplants and bone graft substitutes, bone-growing proteins, and tissue grafting
- One of only six research centers in the country participating in the Diabetic Foot Consortium, a National Institutes of Health-funded program seeking new treatments for diabetic foot ulcers
