Procedures and Services

- **Coronary interventions:** Expertise in complex percutaneous coronary intervention (PCI), including microvascular disease testing, complex high-risk indicated (CHIP) PCI and chronic total occlusion (CTO) PCI
- **Valve therapies:** Transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR), mitral and tricuspid edge-to-edge repair (TEER) and transcatheter mitral and tricuspid valve replacement (TMVR, TTVR)
- **Left atrial appendage occlusion (LAAO):** Minimally invasive procedure that reduces stroke risk for patients with atrial fibrillation
- **Heart failure and pulmonary hypertension interventions:** Mechanical support devices, transcatheter shunt implantation and balloon pulmonary angioplasty
- **Adult congenital heart disease:** Transcatheter closure of atrial septal defects (ASD) and patent foramen ovale (PFO) and interventions for complex pulmonary valve and congenital heart conditions


