Genetic Counseling

Expert geneticists and counselors provide preconception consultation, risk assessment and interpretation of complex genetic test results.

Complex Obstetric Medicine

Our center offers specialized care for patients with high-risk pregnancies, pre-existing medical conditions or pregnancy complications, including heart disease, diabetes, autoimmune disorders and placenta accreta spectrum disorders.

Prenatal Diagnostics

Comprehensive ultrasound, cell-free DNA screening, expanded carrier screening and diagnostic testing, including chorionic villus sampling and amniocentesis, are available across five Prenatal Diagnostic Center locations in the Bay Area and one in Monterey, delivering early and accurate answers close to home.

Fetal Treatment Center

With the first fetal treatment center in the U.S., UCSF Health leads in fetal diagnosis and intervention, offering advanced techniques, including rapid genome sequencing. Specialists in maternal-fetal medicine, surgery, cardiology, neurology, radiology, anesthesia and neonatology coordinate comprehensive care for the most complex cases.

Neonatal Critical Care and Pediatric Follow-Up

The only health system in Northern California with two Level IV NICUs, we provide the region's most expansive and highest level of neonatal critical care. Multidisciplinary teams care for all neonates and have special expertise in managing complex conditions, such as cardiac, neurologic, renal and pulmonary disease as well as genetic syndromes. The neonatology teams also support the crucial transition to outpatient long-term follow-up for children with ongoing medical or surgical needs.
